 - When you don't deal with one another properly , you open yourself up to a premature death.

- The disciplines of God is so you are not judged with the world at judgement.
 - Being in the wrong place with the wrong group.

- The idea of the table comes from “fellowship”.
 - Koinonia- coming from the same coin.

 - Our hands must be stretched out to one another.
