



- I Cor. 11:30-34 (NLT)

- When you don't deal with one another properly, you open yourself up to a premature death.




- The disciplines of God is so you are not judged with the world at judgement.
- Being in the wrong place with the wrong group.




- The idea of the table comes from "fellowship".
