

- Numbers 13:26-33
- Passover and Pentecost are only a few weeks apart
- Feast of Tabernacle is a stand alone



- Feast of Tabernacle= Prophetic Feast
- Feast of Tabernacle was a season with no rain
- Spiritually you learn to seasons



- We should know how to answer our opponents
- God does not stretch us beyond what we can handle
- Can you defend the faith?



- The mark of maturity is the ability to discern
- Opposition should not cause you to retreat
- Lack of discernment will cause you to fall for anything



- There are some prayers you should thank God He didn't answer
- Being called does not mean you are prepared for the task



- Part of the Tabernacle is being able to see the giants but understand something larger is happening
- God's will is going to be done



- Temporary setbacks will not stop God's plan-
- 1 Thessalonians 2:18
- God always leaves a remnant
- Only you can stop you!



- You can be hindered
- When you are on the verge of your breakthrough – Satan will send someone to distract you
- It will be someone close to you



- Learn to draw lines in your life.
- You must be defined by God, you must learn to love yourself.
- Kadesh Barnea- Deuteronomy 1:19



- Moses' family was mad because he married an Ethiopian –Numbers 12
- It's never about what surrounds you it's about you surrounding it.



- Believing you can overcome does not mean being in denial
- You must pay attention otherwise you can be defeated



- Acknowledge where you are but fight to get where God wants you to be.
- It's not about what you see, it's about what He says



- What God brings you out, should be the cause you are championing
